Jarmila Zimmermannova is an associate professor at the Science and Research Centre, Faculty of Health Sciences, Palacky University Olomouc, Czech Republic.

She realised her master's and Ph.D. studies at the University of Economics, Prague, Czech Republic. She continued in collaboration with the University of Economics after her studies and did her habilitation here. She became an associate professor of finance in 2017.

In the period 2003 - 2009, she held various positions at the Ministry of the Environment of the Czech Republic in Prague, most recently as Deputy Director of the Department of Sustainable Energy and Transport and Head of the Department of Environmental Tax Reform and Transport. She represented the ministry in the OECD working group - Joint Meetings of Tax and Environment Experts.

In the period 2011 – 2022, she worked as a researcher and associate professor at Moravian Business College Olomouc, Czech Republic, including managerial positions as Vice-rector for Research, Science, and Development (2013-2018) and Rector (2018 – 2022).

She is head of the socio-economic section of the Bioeconomy Platform of the Czech Republic. Since March 2022, she has been a member of the Circular Bio-based Europe Joint Undertaking (CBE JU) Scientific Committee.

As for her scientific activities, she focuses mainly on the financial and economic instruments of environmental protection, ex-ante and ex-post analyses of economic tools in the air and climate protection, such as environmental taxes, tradable emissions allowances, and others.
